## About us

Montem Resources is a steelmaking coal development company with assets in the Crowsnest Pass, Alberta, Canada.

The company has two main assets, the Tent Mountain mine, capable of producing approximately 1.2Mtpa of steelmaking coal for export, and the Chinook Project, which is a multi-mine development with the potential to produce in excess of 5Mtpa.

The primary focus is to restart mining at the Tent Mountain mine as soon as practical. Once updated permits are in place, all processing and coal loading will occur at Tent Mountain, away from Coleman. It is estimated there is 64Mt of steelmaking coal within the existing mine area. The Feasibility Study shows the open-cut mine will produce 1.2 million tonnes per year for export for 15 years. Once mined, coal will be transported via rail to Vancouver for export.

## Economic benefits

Development of the Tent Mountain mine will bring significant economic benefits to the region. This will include direct full-time employment opportunities with Montem, as well as significant flow-through indirect employment opportunities with local and regional companies. Our mine plan indicates re-starting the mine will create:

- 200+ construction jobs
- 150+ mining jobs during production

Our aim is to use local businesses wherever possible, and to invest in our community.

## Mining at Tent Mountain

### High quality steel making coal

Small scale underground mining first started at Tent Mountain in the early 1900s and was carried out until the 1940s. In 1948 the first open-cut mine was opened at Tent Mountain and continued until 1983 when operations were suspended.

Montem purchased the mine site in 2016 from a US-based company. We have since conducted multiple exploration programs and extensive environmental monitoring as well as numerous environmental, geological and engineering studies, all in an effort to design a feasible mine plan for Tent Mountain. This mine plan will accompany an updated environmental affects assessment which will be provided to the government to enable mining to restart at Tent Mountain.

Once the mine plan is finalized and the appropriate permits are in place, Montem will construct a new processing plant and rail loadout, along with other key infrastructure. The mine is expected to operate for approximately 15 years.

## Committed to minimizing our environment impact

Environmental studies and monitoring are underway at the Tent Mountain mine. Baseline studies provide a thorough understanding of the existing environmental conditions of the mine site.

These studies include the following assessments: air quality, noise, surface and ground water, local vegetation, soil, land resource and local wildlife. This information will help guide the operation and reclamation of the mine. Our priority is to minimize potential impacts on the local environment.

Montem is determined to achieve a best practice standard for environmental management and protection across all aspects of our operations.
